Our continued effort and support has reduced the number of people dying from heart disease each year. The CDC reports that heart disease deaths have dropped 1.8%.

The program promotes physical movement and heart health through the jump rope and basketball activities the kids do in P.E. class for the event.



Not only do the kids receive prizes from the American Heart Association for their fundraising efforts, but they also enjoy treats and educational materials during the event. There will be many incentives; ducks, Bucks basketball tickets, special activities for the top fundraisers and top class! New 2015 incentives include Milwaukee Wave tickets, as well as passes to Rock Sports complex and Helium Trampoline Park.


